

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY ACT

Red Deer Public Library FOIP Bylaw

Purpose

The purpose of the bylaw is to establish the administrative structure of Red Deer Public Library in relation to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act and to set fees there under.

Definitions

In this bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:

"Act" means the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, S.A. 1994, c.F-18.5;

"Applicant" means the Red Deer Public Library and includes any board or committee that is created by the Red Deer Public Library and all members or officers of which are appointed or chosen by Red Deer Public Library;

"Director" means the person appointed as the Director of Red Deer Public Library and includes any person who holds the position of Director in an acting capacity.
Designated Head

The Director shall be responsible and accountable for all decisions taken under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.

Fees

Where an Applicant is required to pay a fee for services, the fee payable is in accordance with the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Regulation, AR 200195, as amended from time to time.

Effective Date

The bylaw comes into effect on May 15, 2002.
