BORROWER'S CARDS

Any person wishing to borrow any item owned by the Library or to acquire material from other libraries through inter-library loan shall be required to hold a valid Borrower's Card, issued by Red Deer Public Library. Types of cards and costs of acquiring same are set out in the By-Law and schedules of the Red Deer Library Board.

BORROWER'S FEES

Borrower's fees were introduced in January 1991.

There shall be an annual review of the following:

1. Elimination or reduction of fees
2. Consideration of other sources of revenue as an alternative to increasing fees.

Refusals to renew or join the library should be monitored.

Any person indicating inability to pay may be provided with a Borrower's Card free of charge.
