***Alleyscapes***, an exhibition of twelve charcoal and pastel drawings featuring alleyways in Red Deer, by local artist Paul Boulton.

The idea for ***Alleyscapes*** was conceived during a visit to Vancouver where "the world of the urban alley triggered wild flights of imagination" in the artist. On returning to his studio, Boulton worked from photographs of Red Deer alleyways, beginning close to reality before reducing the site to its essential components and shapes – "an abstraction of reality in order to highlight the essence of place."

**ALLEYSCAPES**, by Paul Boulton, will be on display at the **Red Deer Public Library** in **Red Deer** from January 30 to February 28, 2003. We welcome your visit to this highly entertaining and informative exhibition.
