




Libby for Mobile Devices

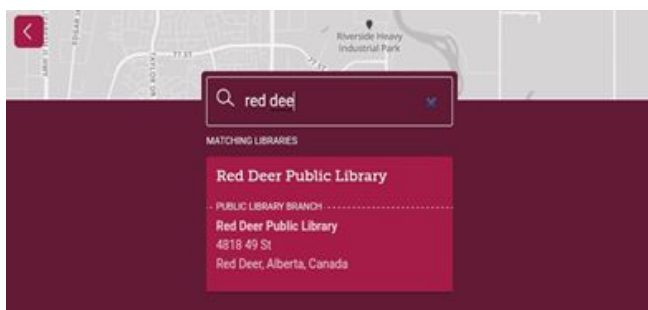
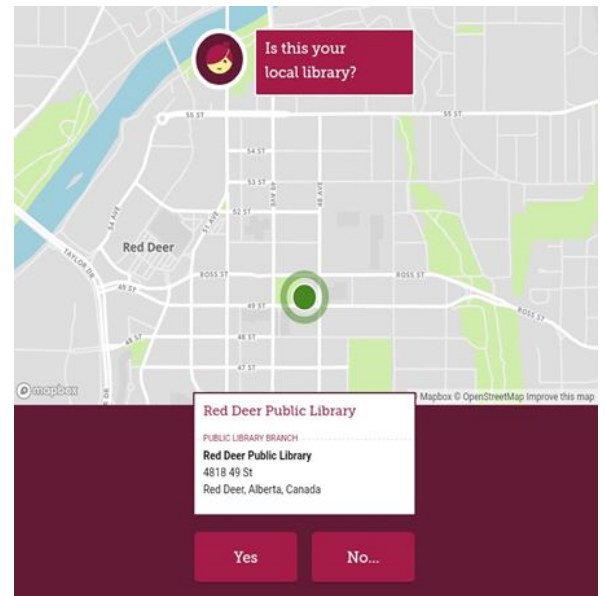
Libby, by Overdrive is an app that allows users to download and read or listen to ebooks and eAudiobooks. Libby is available for iOS (iPhone/iPad), Android, and Windows 10 devices.

Note: To get Libby, you'll need to be familiar with setting up wi-fi, and downloading apps on the device. If you are not comfortable with this, please refer to the Android OS or Apple iOS training documentation first for detailed instructions.

For the purposes of this document it is assumed that the Overdrive app is already installed on the device, and the wifi is enabled.

Step One: Add your Library

- Open the App. Tap the  Button
- Scroll down and tap the **Find my Library** button.
- The App will automatically find the library closest to your location. If it is correct, tap **Yes**.
- If not, search manually by typing the name of your library. Once you have found the right one, tap on it.



Step Two: Add your Library Card

- You will now be able to see the digital library site.
- You can add your card information now by tapping **Add Your Card** or do it when prompted your first time checking out a book.

Note: Users that have multiple cards at the same library can add as many cards as they wish by repeating this process.



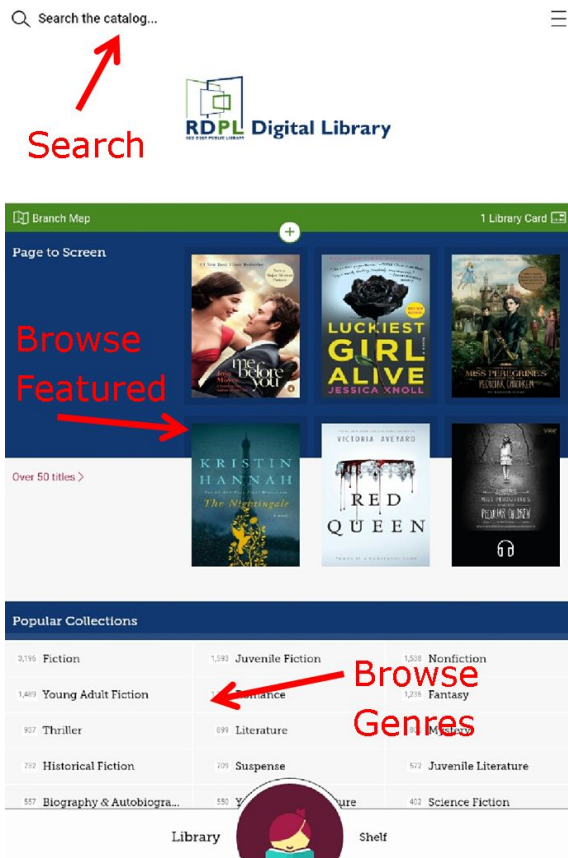
- Input your whole library card number and PIN into the form, then press **SIGN IN**.

You will only need to do this once! If you previously used Overdrive, any borrowed items will transfer over to Libby.

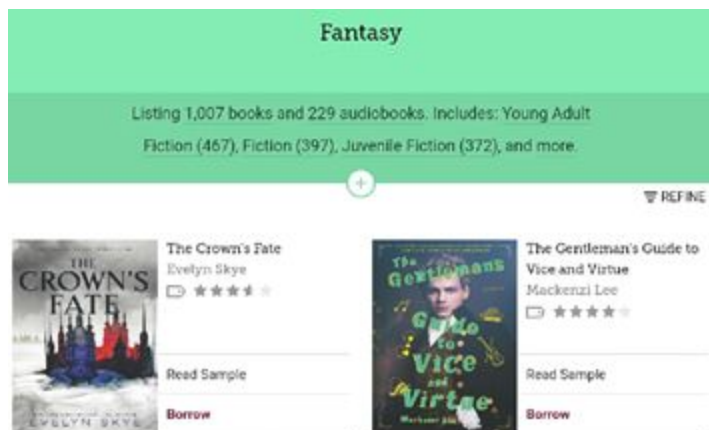
Step 3: Get some Books!

You can browse or search for Libby's eBooks and eAudiobooks in 3 ways.

- If you are looking for something specific, you can type a name, author or series into the search bar at the top of the screen. **Look for the Magnifying Glass Icon.**
- You can browse through featured books and audiobooks by scrolling on the main page. **Scroll and tap on Cover Art.**
- If you are looking for something in a particular genre, you can search "Collections". **Choose a genre from "Popular Collections" or browse all with "Explore our Collections".**



- If you search a collection, you can search more narrowly by tapping on the underlined words below.



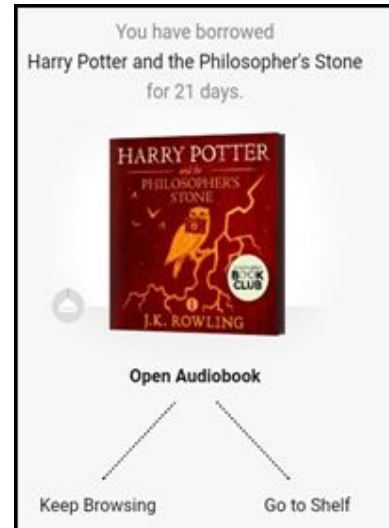

To borrow a book, tap the **Borrow** button. If the book is currently being used, you can **Place a hold**. You will automatically borrow the hold when it is your turn.



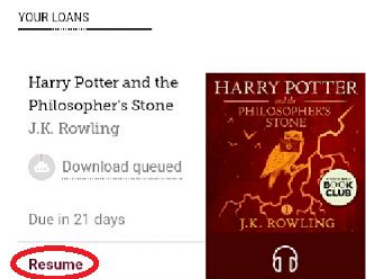
Audiobooks are indicated by the Headphone icon on the bottom of the cover art.

- Confirm the checkout by pressing the pink **Borrow!** button.
- You can start reading immediately by tapping **Open Book/Audiobook**.
- You can also go back to browsing by tapping **Keep Browsing**, or look at all your borrowed items by tapping **Go to Shelf**.



Loans Holds Tags Activity

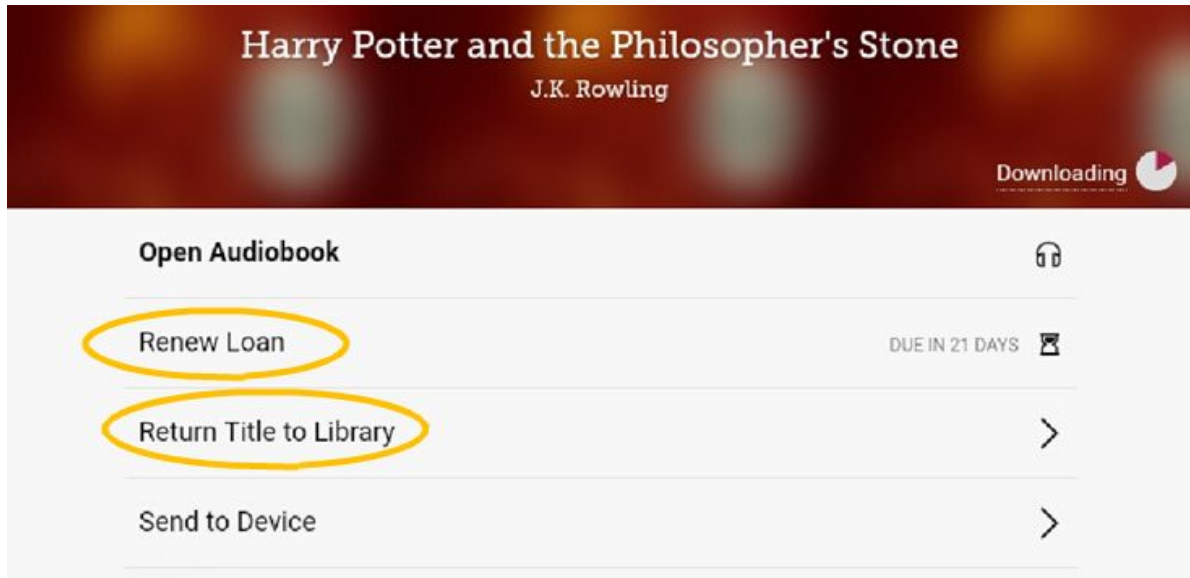
All of your borrowed items are on your **Shelf**, which is always located at the bottom right of the screen. To continue reading a book you have already started, find it on your shelf under the **Loans** tab, and press the **Resume** button.



Step 4: Renew and Return Loans

Tap on a book on your shelf to see the details.

If you wish to return a book early, you can tap on the **Return Title to Library** > then confirm the return when prompted.



You can renew a loan within *three days of the due date* as long as there are no holds on the item. The hourglass next to **Renew Loan** will turn into a > when you are able to renew an item.
