ELEVATOR INTERRUPTIONS AT RED DEER PUBLIC LIBRARY'S DOWNTOWN BRANCH

The elevator at the Downtown Branch of Red Deer Public Library is out of service until further notice.

For those unable to use stairs easily, no elevator service limits Library access to the following areas, collections and services:

- Snell Auditorium, basement washrooms and the Kiwanis Gallery
- Level 2 - Adult-level movies, music, novels and large print collections)
- Quiet space, non-fiction books, magazines, public access computers, printers and washrooms on Level 4
- the mezz - young adult books, games and magazines and the Waskasoo/Kiwanis Meeting Room)

We apologize for this inconvenience and suggest those unable to use stairs and wanting to browse our collections freely, read newspapers, study quietly and use public access computers and printers, visit the Dawe and Timberlands Branches during the time that our elevator is under repair.
